- **3. Coach:** The engaging of a coach will depend on there being sufficient demand. The cost per person is €40. Those travelling by coach may park their cars in Cathal Brugha Barracks provided that car registration numbers are included on the application form.
- **4. Private cars:** For those travelling in private cars, the rendezvous will be: Military Barracks, Wexford Town, on **Sunday** at 10.45hrs; and at the Brandon House Hotel, New Ross on **Monday** at 09.45hrs.
- **5. Accommodation:** The Society has booked a limited number of rooms at The Brandon House Hotel, New Ross at a discounted price. The cost is ϵ 65 per person sharing in double room for one night bed and breakfast and a communal dinner. There is a single room supplement of ϵ 25. Single rooms are limited.
